Emory Hill And Company Receives 2008 DCA Award for Plumbers and Pipefitters Construction Project

New Castle, Del., October, 2008 – On Wednesday, October 29, members of the Emory Hill and Company construction team were presented with the Delaware Contractors Association Construction Excellence Award for the construction of Plumbers and Pipefitters Local #74 in Newark. The award was given in the category of General Building over \$5million.

Emory Hill and Company completed the construction of Plumbers and Pipefitters Local #74 in August. After condemnation of their former facility due to flooding and their subsequent displacement, the Union's new site at the Route 896 entrance of the Pencader Corporate Center was identified and two-phase construction began.

The first phase consisted of the construction of a 38,089 square foot facility to serve the Union following their move and to provide additional space for offices, meeting and training areas, and banquet facilities. The second phase, not yet begun, allows for future expansion.

Eric Kellmyer, Project Manager with Emory Hill and Company, oversaw the project with Doug Westcott serving as the Site Superintendent. Joining them at the award ceremony were Bob Hill, President of Emory Hill and Company; Bob Liberato, Chief Estimator of Emory Hill and Company; Bill Lenihan, Architect, and Susan Vandegrift with Tevebaugh Associates; and Anthony M. Papili from Plumbers and Pipefitters Local #74.
